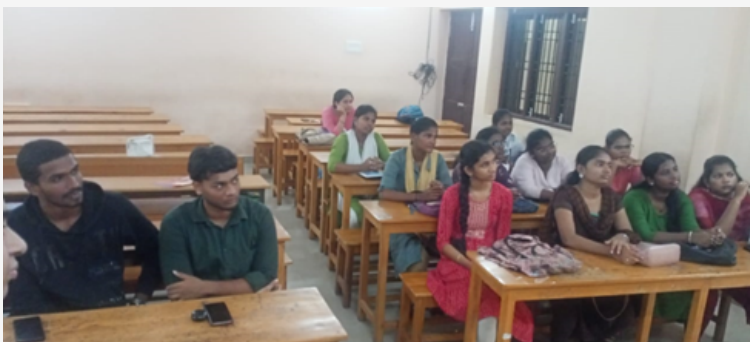
Remembering Mr. Verghese Eapen: First Donor of STF

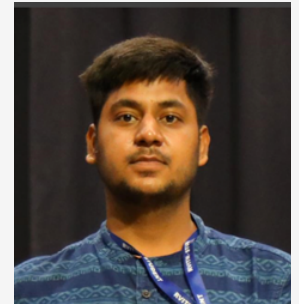

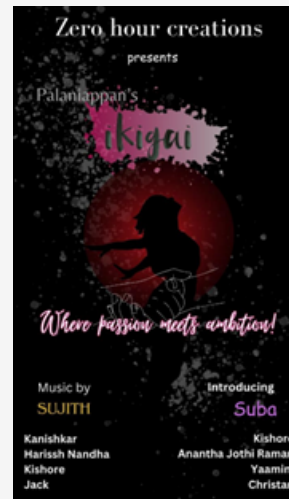
